




Main components and Interfaces for EUDI Wallet



CEN- Draft TS Guidelines for the onboarding of user personal identification data within European Digital Identity Wallets

Overlap:

- ♥ Common syntax:
 - o CEN: Personal identification data
 - ETSI: electronic attestation of attributes
- ♥ Common identity proofing requirements:
 - CEN: Personal identification data
 - ETSI: electronic attestation of attributes
 - ETSI: Signing certificates
